ISO 9001:2015 Latest Update

Where are we in the revision process?

According to the latest news from "iso.org", the DIS has reached the Final Draft International Stage, by achieving a 90% approval vote. Now the ISO subcommittee revising the standard will go through all comments received in order to produce the final draft, which will then be put forward for another vote. Once approved, the standard can be published.

ISO 9001:2015 is on schedule to be published by the end of 2015.

Dr. Nigel Croft, Chair of the ISO subcommittee that is revising ISO 9001, explains what are the main changes and next steps in the revision.

"We are on the right track, and we are on schedule for publication," says Nigel Croft, Chair of the ISO subcommittee revising the standard. He adds, "The new version is very strongly based on three basic core concepts: that process approach which was very successful in the 2008 version of the standard superimposed on that system of processes is the plando-check act methodology, and a third core concept which is new in the 2015 version is risk based thinking, aiming at preventing undesirable outcomes."
